Medications

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| Colace 100mg cap po BID for constipation |
| Cozaar 50mg tab PO QAM for high blood pressure |
| Eligui's 2.5mg tab PO TID to prevent blood clots |
| Norvasc 5mg tab PO QID treats high blood pressure |
| Septtra DS 160/800mg tab PO BID Antibiotics |
| Neurontin 100mg Cap PO TID prevent/control seizures |
| Veriboxetine 20mg PO QID to treat depression |

Medical Interventions:
Staples at surgical site
Antibiotics to prevent infection

Nursing Care: Maintaining clean wound, assisting w/ ADLs
Ice packs as needed

Diet: Regular Diet

Actual or Potential Problems: Infection to surgical site, surgical site opening

Education: acute pain, recent fall, medication.

Discharge: in 2 days

Psychosocial Hx: No wandering behavior, is cooperative

Social Hx: Divorced, denies alcohol, substance use, abuse, self harm, thoughts of self harm, smoking

Diagnostics:
Hip/Pelvis X-Ray - Intertrochanteric fracture of R hip w/ mild associated varices deformity
Chest X-Ray - No acute process demonstrated in chest
Femur X-Ray - No evidence of subtrochanteric fracture in right femur
Hip/Pelvis X-Ray - Status post total right hip arthroplasty
